NHGRA is a member organization representing contractors, consultants and other businesses and individuals whose mission is to encourage the development of a safe, efficient and environmentally sound highway transportation system in New Hampshire. The NHGRA Scholarship, established in 2007, is awarded annually to a student(s) meeting the eligibility requirements set forth in Section II below. **The amount and number of scholarships awarded may vary each year.**

Eligibility

Eligible applicants are limited to the following:

- 1.) Individual members of NH Good Roads Association.
- 2.) Individuals with an ownership interest in a NH Good Roads Association corporate membership.
- 3.) The dependent children of the individuals referenced in 1 and 2 above, pursuing a post-secondary course of study related to the construction industry. It will be within the sole discretion of the governing body of the NHGRA Board of Directors to determine whether the applicants course of study is sufficiently related to this field to qualify of consideration. Applicants must be New Hampshire residents.

Transportation Focus

Although not an express eligibility requirement, preference will be given to applicants demonstrating an intent to use their course of study to pursue a career associated with the transportation industry, including but not limited to, careers related to highway and bridge construction, public works and environmental consulting.
